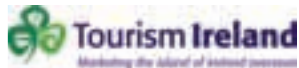

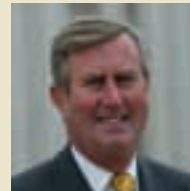

I would like to warmly thank all our Award Sponsors, Patrons, Associate Partners and Consultants for their support and commitment to Good Food Ireland and its members.

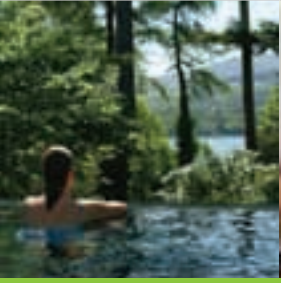
